On June 10-11, municipal representatives from across New Brunswick will participate in an interactive training workshop, focused on knowledge exchange, planning / developing sustainable communities, reducing greenhouse gas emissions, improving efficiency and energy management, and securing economic, social, and environmental benefits for their communities.

This workshop is a highly *hands-on* and *interactive experience*. Facilitators will utilize a variety of demonstrations, worksheet activities, graphic slides, role-plays, case studies and colourful discussions to stimulate a highly *effective* and *enjoyable* learning environment.

Goal: participants gain a better understanding of capital asset management and greenhouse gas inventorying, local action planning and energy management; municipalities are applying best-practices to realize community plans/projects which meet environmental and economic goals.

Target Audience: Municipal planners & planning commissions, administrators, environmental coordinators, department heads, facility managers, public works staff, environmental contract consultants, and/or councillors with environmental portfolios. Additional participants may include: members of the private sector (builders, developers, service providers) and academia, consulting experts, representatives of community/non-profit organizations and finance providers. **Expected # of participants 50-60 (seating is limited, first come first serve)**
